Experimenting

The opportunity to listen to external sessions that you have exclusive access to during this Explore Series.

15-25 minute sessions with your peers that allow you to actively engage with ways of connecting that you may not have experienced before. All networking sessions link to SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals.
